Bursary

(To be eligible for the bursary the applicant must be a resident of [the former] Township of Burford and/or a graduate of a [former] Township of Burford school, [Burford District Elementary School, Blessed Sacrament Elementary School, Oakland-Scotland Public School], and be entering their first or second year of post-secondary studies.)

The Burford Township Historical Society is awarding a \$500 bursary which may be given to one secondary school student who is planning to enter post-secondary studies in either history or an agricultural related program at either the college or university level.

The post-secondary school must be a recognized institution in the Province of Ontario.

The application to qualify for consideration for the bursary consists of completing this application form along with an essay, and submitting to the historical society by May 24, 2024.

- You are entering your first year of studies, or have returned for a second year;
- If you should decide to not attend and/ or to not complete the post-secondary studies in Fall 2024 / Winter 2025, you are obliged to return the bursary.
